Dairy slaughter for the week ending October 12 was 60,300 head; 2,700 head less than the number slaughtered from the same week last year and 500 head less than the week prior. Through the first 41 weeks of the year, slaughter is outpacing 2012 by 48,000 head (+1.99 percent). However, through the first 17 weeks of the year, 2013 slaughter was ahead 53,200 head (+5.14 percent). Since early May to present, 5,200 fewer head

have been slaughtered year-over-year as last year's drought-driven slaughter rates are now behind us.

The U.S. average price for dairy cows in October was \$79.70 per hundredweight (cwt), down \$2.80 per cwt from a revised September price of \$82.50 per cwt. Although lower on the month, the average cull price is \$2.4 per cwt higher than October of 2012, supported by recent recordhigh cash beef prices and live cattle

futures prices.

On October 31, the USDA reported that feedlot placements in September were up 1 percent from September 2012 and in-line market expectations (+1.2 percent). The 2.03 million head placed is 13.4 percent greater than the August placement. The cold storage report released on the same day showed a 3.4 percent month-over-month increase in frozen beef stocks. The 445 million pounds

in stocks is also 4.7 percent more than year-ago levels. The expectation is for tight supplies near-term, but these recent developments may limit the upside of prices.

Live cattle futures sold off a bit following the reports, but December through April contracts still held the \$132 to \$133 per cwt price level. Cash beef traded at \$132 and choice boxed beef cutouts were at \$204.
