Four breed associations honour Canada's master breeders

Canadian breed associations recently recognized some of Canada's top herds with the prestigious Master Breeder award. Presented by Holstein Canada, Jersey Canada, Ayrshire Canada and the Canadian Brown Swiss and Braunvieh Association, the 2019 recipients are highlighted below.

ERSEY

Jersey Canada awarded one Master Breeder shield to a deserving herd. This elite award is based on long-term excellence in the breed, and it is calculated using both production and classification data.

In addition, Jersey Canada recognized these constructive breeders. The Constructive Breeder award recognizes herds that are excelling in Jersey breeding over a shorter time frame than the Master Breeder. Animals eligible for constructive breeder points are born during a five-year window, beginning three years before the year of calculation. Three constructive breeders are awarded per year to the three eligible herds with the highest average points per registration.
